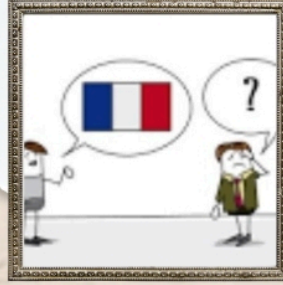
What is the climate of France?

The euro came into force in France on January 1, 2002, as in eleven other countries of the European Union.



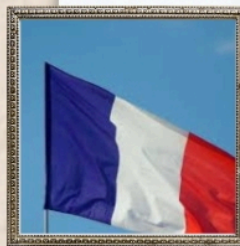
France typical food
