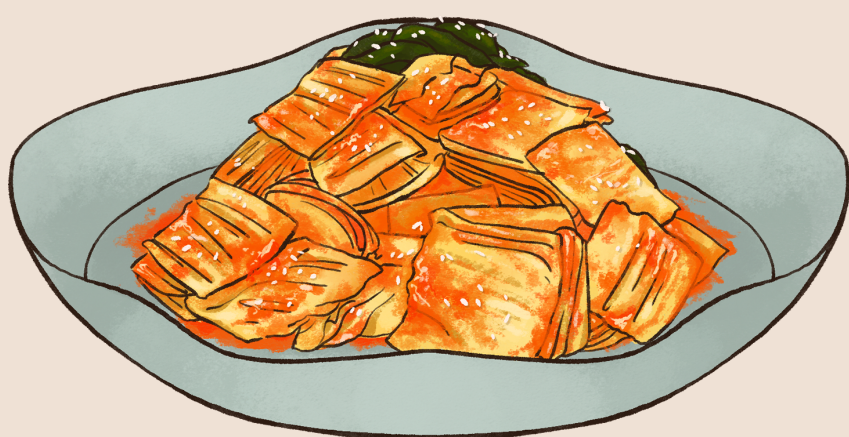
Some of the traditions are:
