MODAL VERB CAN



Use of the modal verb can

It is used to talk about abilities, to ask permission, to make a request, to talk about a possibility or to make an offer. This modal verb can be used with any subject, but always accompanied by a main verb.



Affirmative structure of the modal verb can

Affirmative sentences: Subject + can + verb (infinitive). For example: I can come back later.



I can play the guitar.

(Puedo tocar la guitarra.)



In Spanish the meaning of the verb can is 'to be able or have the ability to' and we could say that it is one of the most used verbs in the daily life of an English speaker

Negative structure of the modal verb can



The negative form of "can" is "can't" (the most frequent) or "cannot" (for situations in which we want to give special emphasis, or if we are angry). Interrogative structure of the modal verb can

INTERROGATIVE: To ask with a modal verb we invert the modal verb with the subject. can + subject + main verb + rest of sentence...? Can you come here? ¿Puedes venir aquí?

I can't play the guitar.

(No puedo tocar la guitarra.)

Can I ask you a question?

(¿Puedo hacerte una pregunta?)

Affirmative Yo sé nadar.

l can swim.

Negative Jenny can't bake cakes (Jenny no sabe hacer tartas).

Can you play tennis?
