VERB CAN

What is the verb can?

(power) is a very popular verb in English that is often used to talk about ability or permission. Can is generally used as a modal verb, meaning that it is always used together with a main verb.

Affirmative

Affirmative sentences: Subject + can + verb (infinitive). For example: I can come back later.

Negative sentences: Subject + can't + verb (infinitive).

Negative

The negative form of "can" is "can't" (the most frequent) or "cannot" (for situations in which we want to give special emphasis, or if we are angry).

Interrogative

Questions are formed with can + subject:

-Can Jodie come to the party?

Puede Jodi venir a la fiesta
