VERBO MODAL CAN




What is it?



It is used to talk about abilities, to ask permission, to make a request, to talk about a possibility or to make an offer. This modal verb can be used with any subject, but always accompanied by a main verb.


AFFIRMATIVA

Affirmative sentences: Subject + can + verb (infinitive). For example: I can come back later. Negative sentences: Subject + can't + verb (infinitive)




NEGATIVE

The negative form of "can" is "can't" (the most frequent) or "cannot" (for situations in which we want to give special emphasis, or if we are angry). Compare these sentences:
-She can't tell you what to do!



Interrogative

Questions are formed with can + subject: -Can Jodie come to the party?
