DEFINITION

A SPECIES IS CONSIDERED EXTINCT WHEN THE LAST KNOWN SPECIMEN DIES WITHOUT LEAVING A GENETIC HEIR.

MEASURES TO RESCUE ANIMALS IN DANGER

- PROTECT THE ECOSYSTEM WHERE THEY LIVE
- REPRODUCE THE SPECIES IN CAPTIVITY

ANIMALS THAT HAVE THE GREATEST DANGER OF EXTINCTION

GIANT PANDA

CAUSE: THE DISAPPEARANCE OF ITS HABITAT, THE BAMBOO FORESTS IN CHINA. CONSEQUENCES: ONLY 1,000 COPIES LEFT IN THE WORLD. THEIR REPRODUCTIVE LEVELS ARE VERY LOW IN CAPTIVITY, SO THEIR SITUATION IS ALARMING.

BLACK RHINOCEROS

CAUSE: HUNTING
CONSEQUENCES: 95% HAVE DISAPPEARED, ONLY 2,000 COPIES LEFT IN THE WORLD.
