LEONBERGER

The Leonberger is a breed of dog native to Germany that owes its name to the German city of Leonberg. They can live 8 to 9 years, they can also weigh Female: 65–75 cm, Male: 72–80 cm their weight Female: 41–64 kg, Male: 50–77 kg

The first time a boxer appeared was in 1895 in Munich by the Munich Boxer Club.



DOBERMAN

The Doberman is a breed of dog of German origin that owes its name to Karl Friedrich Louis Dobermann, a German who, at the end of the 19th century, took the initiative to create a new breed of dog that would effectively serve his difficult job as a collector. of taxes. They have an Intelligent, Alert, Energetic, Obedient, Fearless, Loyal, Confident temperament.

SCHNAUZER

The Schnauzer is a dog breed that originated in Germany during the 15th and 16th centuries. Its name derives from the German Schnauze 'snout', related to Schnauzbar and Schnurrbart 'moustache', given its very characteristic beard that begins at the top of the snout in this breed

The Great Dane is a breed of dog of German origin known for its large size and delicate personality, considered the "Apollo among all breeds" by the International Cynological Federation.

ROTWEILER
