But scientists are also concerned breeding levels in the wild are decreasing and it is almost impossible to get the giant panda to reproduce in captivity.

AFRICAN BLACK
RHINOCEROS

is in danger of extinction mainly due to hunting. Since 1970, 95% of black rhinos have disappeared and it is estimated that only 2,000 individuals remain.

At this rate we can estimate that the black rhino will soon be extinct.
