GIANT PANDA

A small population of the Javan rhinoceros is still clinging to survival on the Indonesian island of Java approximately it has a population in 2019 of only 72 specimens

Pandas live mainly in bamboo forests high in the mountains of western China, on which they subsist almost entirely
BY THIS THEN THERE ARE LESS THAN 2,000 LEFT IN THE FREE

Some ways to avoid the extinction of animals are to prohibit hunting.
Avoid deforestation of different ecosystems.
Delimit protected areas and natural reserves.
Put into practice responsible consumption actions.
Promote plans for breeding in captivity
