Cancer in domestic animals represents almost the half of the deaths of pets over 10 years old dogs get cancer at approximately the same rate than humans, the neoplasia is diagnosed based on according to the medical history and physical examinations have been performed on the pet, in most cases requires additional testing such as x-rays, blood tests and ultrasounds, to be sure that you really have a neoplasia, a biopsy which consists of taking a sample of tissue from the neoplasia to be examined under a microscope.

This disease unfortunately has no prevention anymore. that most neoplasms are not known, so the Timely treatment is the best way to prevent it. exist different types of neoplasms such as skin neoplasia which is very common in older dogs, but much less common in cats, then there are neoplasms in glands mammary, lymphoma in dogs and cats, testicular, neoplasia abdominal, and bones.

Each type of neoplasia requires individual attention and can take some combinations of therapies treatment such as surgeries, chemotherapy, radiation, hyperemia or immunotherapies the health of pets and one As a Veterinarian, you must recommend changes in the diets since this will help the pet respond better in its treatment, the Veterinarian must seek the best treatment options for the pet.

The success rate depends largely on the type and extent of the neoplasia, as well as the aggressiveness of the treatment, the Benign neoplasms are usually easier to treat and it is more It is likely that the treatment of other neoplasms that have successful if they are detected, although some neoplasms especially the most malignant cancers cannot be cure and treatment can prolong the life of the pet and better quality of life
