# The ten dog breeds



## Leonberger

They are kind, calm, faithful and of good character. They get along well with other pets and children and are also playful. They learn quickly and, due to their large size, it is very important to start training them as soon as possible.

## st. bernard

The Saint Bernard is a breed of dog native to the Swiss Alps and northern Italy. It is the most famous Cattle Dog along with the Pyrenean Mastiff, and is very close to the Great Swiss Cattle Dog.



## Landseer

The Landseer is a breed of dog native to Germany and Switzerland. Many kennel clubs consider the Landseer a black and white variant of the Newfoundland, but the International Cynological Federation recognizes it as a separate breed.

## Gran pirineo

The Pyrenean Mountain Dog or Great Pyrenees is a large and majestic breed of dog, traditionally used to protect sheep and used in recent years as a rescue and therapy dog due to its passive and charming instinct.



## Boxer

The Boxer is a breed of working and companion dog of German origin, Molosser type, of medium size. The breed was created from crosses with the Bullenbeisser, Old Time Bulldog, English Bulldog and other undocumented breeds. The first time a boxer appeared was in 1895 in Munich by the Munich Boxer Club.

## Doberman

The Doberman is a breed of dog of German origin that owes its name to Karl Friedrich Louis Dobermann, a German who, at the end of the 19th century, took the initiative to create a new breed of dog that would effectively serve his difficult job as a collector of taxes.



## Schnauzer

The Schnauzer is a dog breed that originated in Germany during the 15 and 16 centuries. Its name derives from the German Schnauze 'snout', related to Schnauzbar and Schnurrbart 'moustache', given its very characteristic beard that begins at the top of the snout in this breed.

## Great dane

The Great Dane is a breed of dog of German origin known for its large size and delicate personality, considered the "Apollo among all breeds" by the International Cynological Federation.



## Hovawart

The Hovawart is a large breed of dog native to the Black Forest in southwestern Germany. This breed has a typically black coloration, although it is possible to find other layers. Well spread throughout Europe, the origins of Hovawart date back to the 13th century.

## Rottweiler

The Rottweiler is a molosser-type dog breed originally from Germany, although it was also used in ancient Rome. The well-bred Rottweiler is not a dangerous breed. Raised with love, without mistreatment, shouting or harsh punishments out of time.
