¿what is?

They are conditions that interfere with the proper functioning of the liver, bile ducts, gallbladder and pancreas. They mostly occur in small species

symptoms

Some symptoms are abdominal pain especially in the upper right side of the abdomen below the rib cage.
Nausea or vomiting
Loss of appetite that can result in weight loss
Fatigue

treatment

Some treatments for hepatobiliary diseases are symptomatic therapy
Specific therapy antibiotics in case of infection ursodeoxycholic acid for cholestasis, surgical interventions to treat tumors or PSS and anti-inflammatories
Switch to a special diet food
Liver protectors
