signs

Difficulty urinating, such as stranguria, frequency, or hematuria
Fatigue
Little appetite
Behavioral disorders
Fever
Vomiting
Diarrhea
Weightloss

What is hepatobiliary?

It is a specialty that is responsible for all those injuries found in the liver, bile ducts and pancreas, which are susceptible to surgical and non-surgical management.

Causes

- Obesity and cholesterol.
- Derivations from other diseases such as cancers or tumors.
- Genetic and hereditary predispositions.
- Exposure to chemicals or toxins.

What causes gallstone disease?

In most cases, one of the causes of cholecystitis is the accumulation of hard particles in the gallbladder (gallstones). Gallstones can block the pathway (the cystic duct) through which bile flows as it leaves the gallbladder.
