## MAIN ORGAN AFFECTED.

The tugh blood flow make it exceptionally sansitive to injury caused by systemic diseasa processes

## DEVELOPMENT OF THE DISEASE.

It can progress to cirrhosis of the liver and the development of bile duct tumors They make and store ble la fluid produced by the liver that helps digest fat), and release it into the smal' intestine

## CLINICAL SIGNS

Intermittent anorexia, polydipsia/polyuria, vomiting lethargy It occurs when blood flow bypasses the liver, causing a buildup of taxeru

## HOW IS IT AFFECTING

Liver problems or lver disease are a fairly comman condition in adult dogs. It could cause secures, induce zoma and even death in more severe cases

## THERAPIST OPTIONS

Fluid thorsoy, maintenance of acid-bose and slectrolyte balance, control of hypoglycemia and nutritional support.

It is important to promote liver regeneration and maintain the aramal's body weight

## HOW TO PREVENT

1. Provide a healthy, balanced diet that covers all your nutnional needs.
  2. Emure that your pet gets meugh physical exercise
- Take him for general check-ups and get him vaccinated, including the vaccine that protects him against leptospirosis
