# ENDANGERED FAUNA

## Panda

The giant panda or panda is categorized as 'endangered' within the conservation status levels.

This animal only lives in China. It is believed that there are only about 1,000 giant pandas left. The main threat to this animal is the gradual disappearance of the bamboo forests where it lives.

Scientists are also concerned because their reproductive levels in the wild are decreasing and it is almost impossible to get the giant panda to reproduce in captivity.

This peaceful animal, lover of bamboo and with a gentle appearance, faces multiple threats, and habitat fragmentation

## Black Rhinoceros

The species is in serious danger of extinction as it has been a victim of poaching for decades.

Since 1970, 95% of black rhinos have disappeared and now it is estimated that only 2,000 remain. At this rate, we can calculate that the black rhino will soon become extinct.

There is a way to save rhinos from extinction, but it requires fighting international mafias that buy and sell rhino horns.

Blackrhinoceroses live in shrublands, tropical and subtropical grasslands, montane forests, savannas.

## Tiger

Although this species was at one time very reproducing common, now there are only 6,000 tigers left in all the world.

Tigers are losing their habitat daily due to human activities and are also being killed by poachers to obtain their skins and other parts of their bodies.

The main threats affecting the tiger population are deforestation and as always, humans themselves.

To save tigers, we need to ensure forest and grassland habitats throughout Asia.
