PANDA



The panda, panda bear or giant panda (*Ailuropoda melanoleuca*) is a species of mammal in the order of carnivores.

The spectacled bear being its closest relative, which belongs to the tremarctine subfamily. Native to central China, the giant panda lives in mountainous regions, mainly those of Sichuan, up to an altitude of 3,500 m above sea level. n. m.

The main threat to this animal is the gradual disappearance of the bamboo forests where it lives. Scientists are also concerned because their reproductive levels in the wild are decreasing and it is almost impossible to get the giant panda to reproduce in captivity.

BLACK RHINOCEROS

The black or hook-lipped rhinoceros (*Diceros bicornis*) is a species of perissodactyl mammal of the rhinoceros family. It is one of the two rhinos that live in the African savannah.

It is critically endangered, and at least two of its subspecies, *Diceros bicornis bruccii* and *Diceros bicornis longipes*, the latter known as the western black rhinoceros, have become extinct due to poaching. In cases like Mozambique, the black rhinoceros has disappeared from the country.

There is a way to save rhinos from extinction, but it requires fighting the international mafias that buy and sell rhino horns.

The 'Panthera tigris tigris' is the largest feline in the world, but its majesty and fame have been one of the reasons why there are barely a few thousand living specimens today.

Currently many organizations are responsible for drawing up lists of animals in danger of extinction with the aim of sensitising public opinion and warning governments of the need to protect these species.
