2. You buy what she buys at the store.
3. Gerardo sings in the shower.

5. It gets tough when the midterms come.
6. We drink apple juice after going to church.
7. They wash clothes in the river when the sun sets.

### Negative form.

Subject+Auxiliary verb+Not+Principal verb+Complement

1. Monica doesn't speak English at home.
2. We don't pay for electricity in the CFE

### Interrogative form

Auxiliary verb+Subject+Principal verb+Complement+?

1. Do you take the bus to go to school?
2. Does she have blue meth in her pointer?
