The inverted house

In Szymbark, Poland, there is a construction that breaks with any commandment of architecture. The Upside Down House -or the inverted house- was created by Daniel Czapiewski with the idea of illustrating the communist era and graphing the changes that have occurred today. As if everything was turned upside down.



The toilet house

Called Haewoojae, in Suwon, South Korea, there is a striking house shaped like a typical toilet. Built by Sim Jae-duck, former head of the World Toilet Association organization, the building is intended to help raise awareness about the need to improve public health. Its 419 square meters include two floors with 4 bedrooms (two of them guest) and three luxury toilets.



The narrowest

Between two buildings of traditional dimensions, is the Keret House erected by the Polish architect Jakub Szczesny in Warsaw. The peculiar aluminum and plastic construction is 10 meters high and exactly 92 centimeters wide. The guest can access the heart of the home through a staircase.



The skate house

Pierre-André Senizergues, the owner of Etnies, a sports brand of sneakers, clothing and accessories, built every skate fan's dream. In his house in Malibu, each piece of furniture is designed to be prone to skateboard maneuvers. 200 square meters of an indoor course that brings together enthusiasts.
