My house has a porch, a master bedroom, a guest bedroom, a living and dining room, a kitchen, a bathroom, a hallway and a large patio.

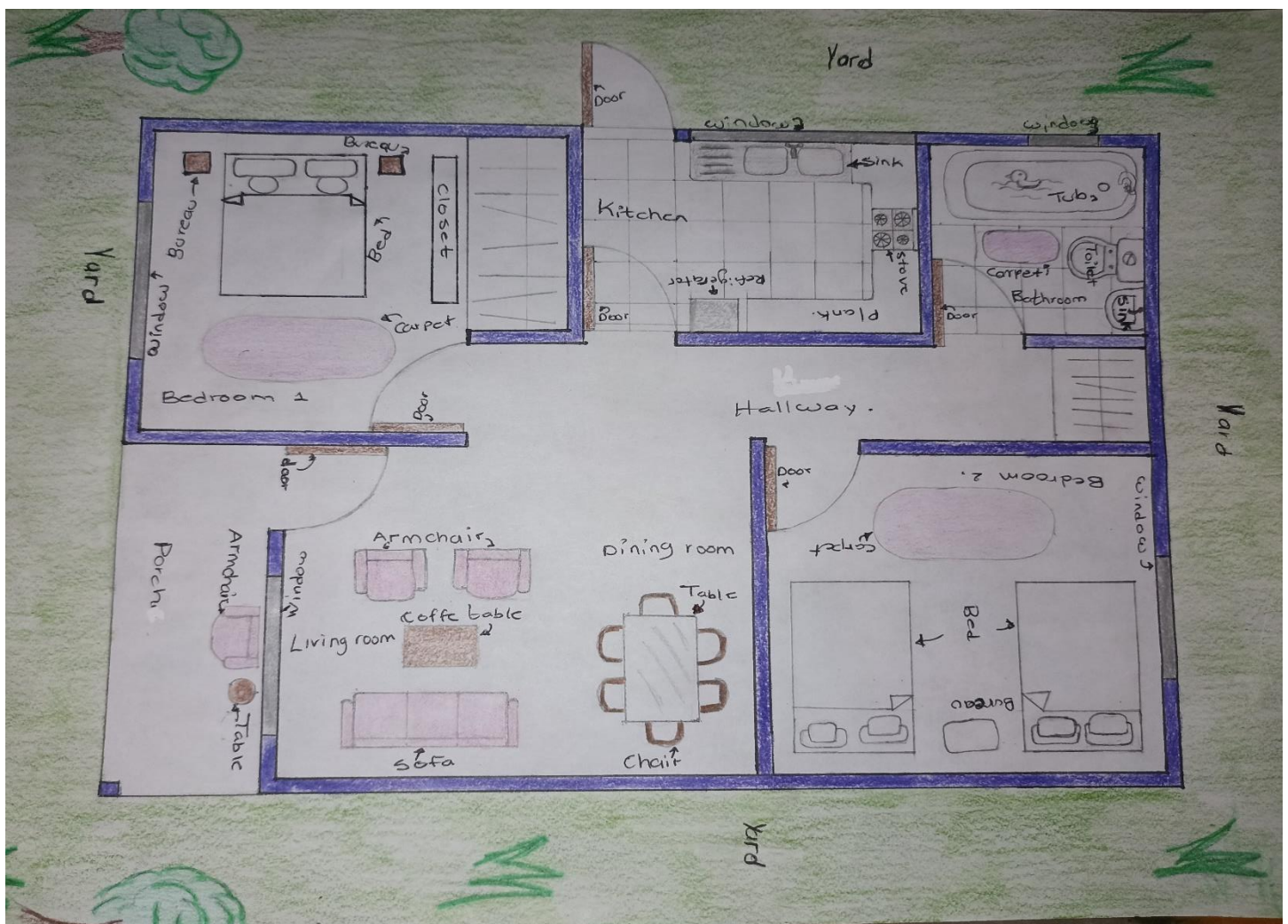
On the porch is an armchair and a table.

In the master bedroom there is a King size bed, a large closet, two bureaus, a carpet and a Window.

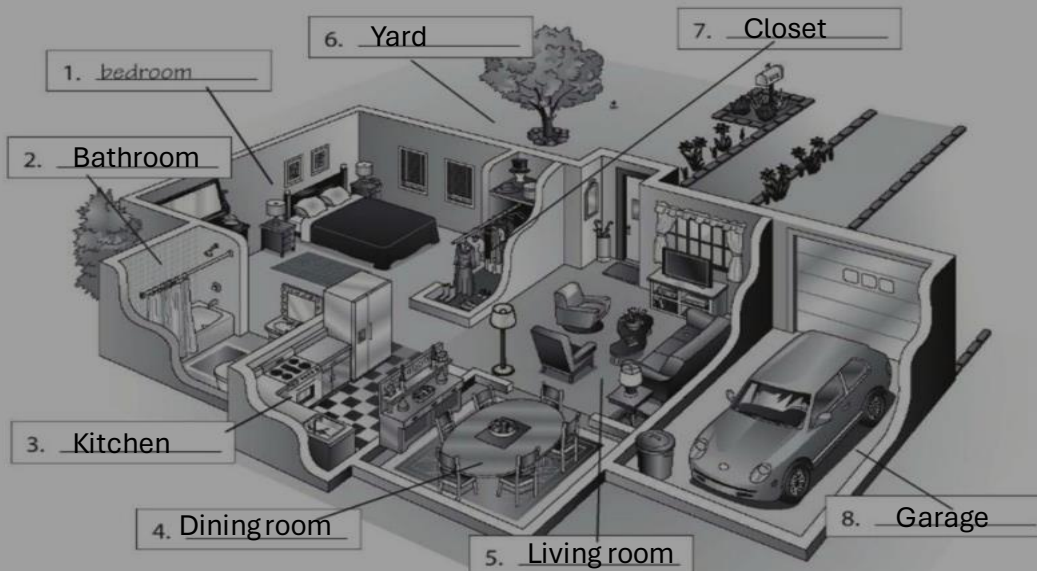
