• Spelling Rules (ING)

Rule 1

Verbs that end in "e"
Delete the "e" and add "ing"

Example:

Make - Making Dance - Dancing

write - writing

Rule 2

Verbs that end in "ie"
Delete (ie) and add "ying"

Example:

Lie - Lying Tie: Tying

Die - Dying

Rule 3

One syllable verbs and that

end in one

vowel and one consonant

Double the consonant and add "ing"

Example:

Swim: Swimming Run: Running

Rule 4

If the verb ends in two
consonant

Don't double the consonant!

Examples:

Work - working wash: washing

Help - Helping

Rule 5

If the verbs ends in two vowels
and the one consonant don't
double the consonant.

Example:

Need: Needing

wait: waiting

Speak: Speaking

Rule 6

Two or more syllables if the
last syllable is not stressed
do not double consonant.

Example:

Happen: Happening

visit: visiting

Remember: Remembering

Rules 7.

Two or more syllables if the last syllable is stressed double the last consonant

Example

Begin: Beginning

Prefer: Preferring

Forget: forgetting

Rules 8.

In the verb ends in "y" or "ce" don't double the consonant.

Example:

Enjoy: Enjoying

Blow: Blowing

Study: Studying

Snow: Snowing
