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Rules...

Rule 1

Verbs that end in "e"

Delete the "e" and add "ing"

Examples

Make - Making

Write - Writing

Dance - Dancing

Close - Closing

Date - Dating

Rule 2

Verbs that end in "ie"

Delete "ie" and add "ying"

Examples

Lie - Lying

Die - Dying

Tie - Tying

Untie - Untying

Hie - Hying

Rule 3

One-syllable verbs that end in one vowel and one consonant

Double the consonant and add "ing"

Examples

Swim - Swimming

Stop - Stopping

Run - Running

Win - Winning

Rule 4

If the verbs ends in two consonants don't double the consonant.

Examples

Work - Working

Help - Helping

Wash - Washing

Add - Adding

Rule 5

If the verbs ends in two vowels and one consonant

don't double the consonant.

Examples

Need - Needing

Wait - Waiting

Speak - Speaking

Rule 6

Two or more syllables if the last syllable is not stressed, do not double consonant

Examples

Happen - Happening

Visit - Visiting

Remember - Remembering

Rule 7

Two or more syllables if the last syllable is stressed double the last consonant

Examples

Begin - Beginning

Prefer - Preferring

Forget - Forgetting

Rule 8

If the verbs ends in "y" or "w" don't double the consonant

Examples

Enjoy - Enjoying

Blow - Blowing

Study - Studying

Snow - Snowing

Subject + V-a + Gerund + Complement

Subject + V-a + Not + Gerund + complement

V-a + Subject + Gerund + complement + ?

- + she was doing her homework when you went to the mall
- she was not doing her homework when you went to the mall
- ? was she doing her homework when you went to the mall ?
