Cultural and Historical Attractions

Paseo de Montejo: Take a stroll down this grand avenue lined with colonial-era mansions and visit the iconic Monument a la Patria.

Palacio Cantón: Visit this elegant mansion, which now houses the Regional Museum of Anthropology and History, to learn about the Yucatán's history and culture.

Activities

Biking on Paseo de Montejo: Rent a bike and explore the city's grand avenue, Paseo de Montejo, lined with sculptures, cafes, and historic sites.

Dzibilchaltún Archaeological Site: Visit this Mayan archaeological site located just outside Mérida, featuring the Temple of the Seven Dolls and a cenote.
