BY THEN, GERMANY WAS UNDER THE RULE OF ADOLF HITLER, LEADER OF THE NAZI PARTY, APPOINTED VCANCELLER IN 1933.



AFTER ENSURING THE NEUTRALITY OF THE USSR WITH THE RIBBENTROP-MOLOTOV NON-AGGRESSION PACT SIGNED ON AUGUST 23, 1939, GERMANY INVADED POLAND ON SEPTEMBER 1, WHICH DETONATED THE DECLARATION OF WAR OF THE GREAT POWERS AGAINST THE THIRD REICH ON SEPTEMBER 3.

TWO YEARS LATER, HITLER OPENED THE EASTERN FRONT BY ORDERING "OPERATION BARBAROSSA" AGAINST THE USSR ON JUNE 22, 1941. THE CRUELEST BATTLES OF THE WAR WERE FOUGHT ON THE EASTERN FRONT.

THE DECISIVE BATTLE TO END THE WAR WAS KNOWN AS "OPERATION OVERLORD" AFTER THE LANDING OF THE TROOPS IN NORMANDY, ON JUNE 6, 1944.

AFTER THE DEATH OF ADOLF HITLER ON APRIL 30, 1945, GERMANY SIGNED THE SURRENDER ON MAY 8 OF THE SAME YEAR, WHICH PUT AN END TO THE WAR.
