Mindy: So where were you last year?

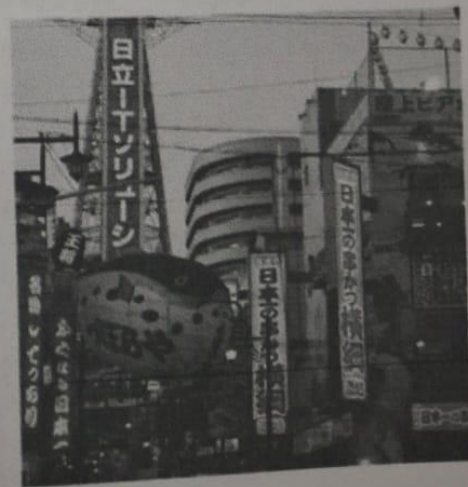
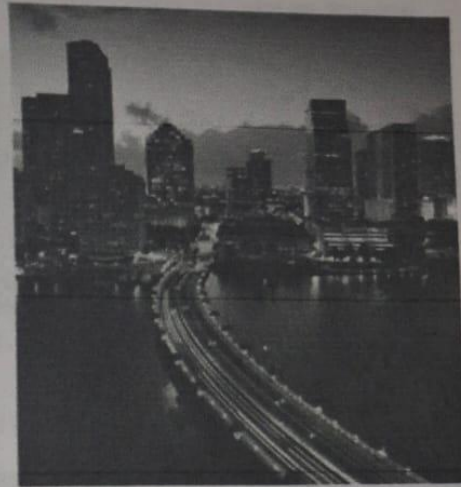
Alan: I was in Japan.

Mindy: What were the job?

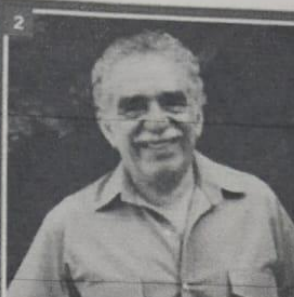

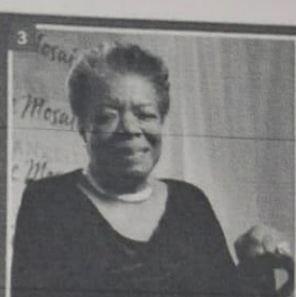
