Jason: Really? How old were you then?

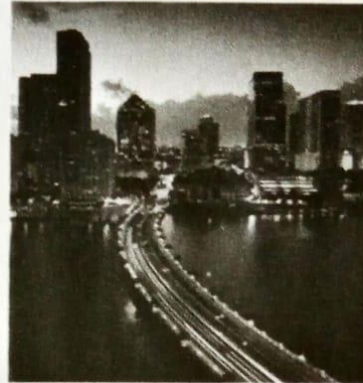
