- painted *The Persistence of Memory*, 1931

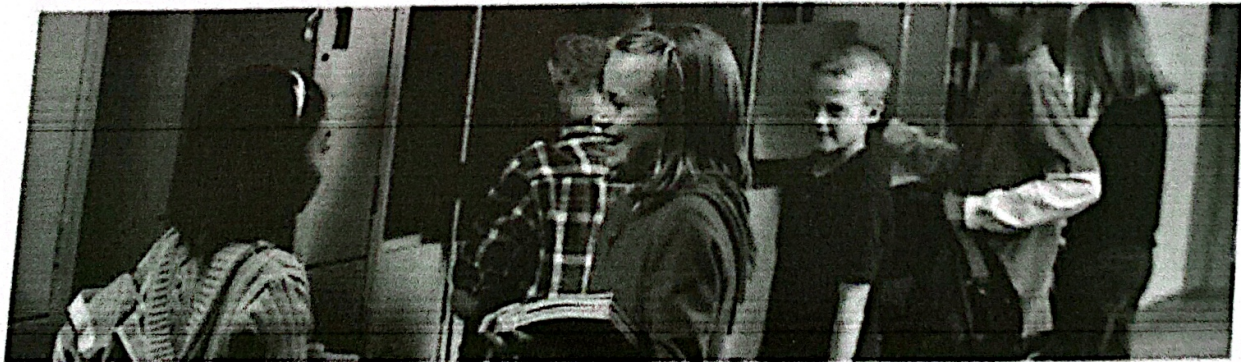
