Affirmative Form Grammatical structure:

SUBJECT + **WAS** - **WERE** +
COMPLEMENT.

- I was at the concert.
- You were very serious.
- He was at home when I called.

Negative Form Grammatical structure:

SUBJECT + **WASN'T** - **WEREN'T**
+ **COMPLEMENT.**

- I wasn't happy to see you.
- We weren't happy with our hotel.
- It wasn't a good movie.

Interrogative Form Grammatical structure:

WAS - **WERE** + **SUBJECT** +
COMPLEMENT ?

- Was she cooking a cake?
- Were they here yesterday?
