be + going to +
Infinitive verb
+ complement.

You are going to play soccer.

He's going to color the draw.

Negative form

Grammar st:

Subject + verb to
be + not + going to
+ verb in
infinitive +
complement.

I'm not going to study law in that university.

We are not going to spend all day together.

It's not going to swim at the beach.

Interrogative form

Grammar st:

Verb to be +
Subject + going to +
Infinitive verb
+ complement?

Is she going to drive here?

Are they going to come tonight?
