# Future "be going to"

## Affirmative Form Grammatical structure:

SUBJECT + TOBE + GOING TO  
+ VERB + COMPLEMENT.

- I am going to be a vet when I grow up
- You are going to listen to me, even if you don't want to.
- He is going to speak at the weekly meeting.

## Negative Form Grammatical structure:

SUBJECT + TOBE (NOT)  
+ GOING TO + VERB  
+ COMPLEMENT.

- I am not going to give up on you.
- We are not going to drink alcohol on the street tonight, guys.
- It is not going to rain today in Mexico.

## Interrogative Form Grammatical structure:

TOBE + SUBJECT + GOING  
TO + VERB + COMPLEMENT?

- Is she going to sing a song for us?
- Are they going to take the piano lessons?
