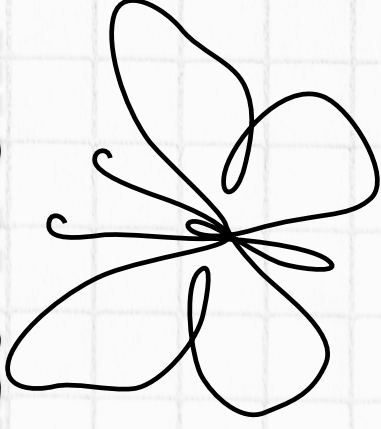

Subject + Was Were +
Complement

- ☆ I was with them last night.
- ☆ You were very happy in your childhood.
- ☆ He was a good manager.

NEGATIVE FORM

Subject + Wasn't/Weren't
+ complement

- ☆ I wasn't a good student.
- ☆ We weren't wrong.
- ☆ It wasn't an interesting question.

INTERROGATIVE FORM

Was/ Were + Subject +
Complement?

- ☆ Were they your friends?
- ☆ Was she a model?
