Affirmative form

Subject+ to be+ going
to+ verb +complement.

I’m going to argue with my dad.

You are going to burn the food.

He’s going to climb the hill.

Negative form

subject +to be(not)+going
to+verb+complement.

I’m not going to decide for you

We aren’t going to examine the exhibition.

It is not going to hit the piñata.

Interrogative form

To be+ subject+ going
to+verb+ complement.

Are they going to learn French?

Is she going to pilot of this flight?
