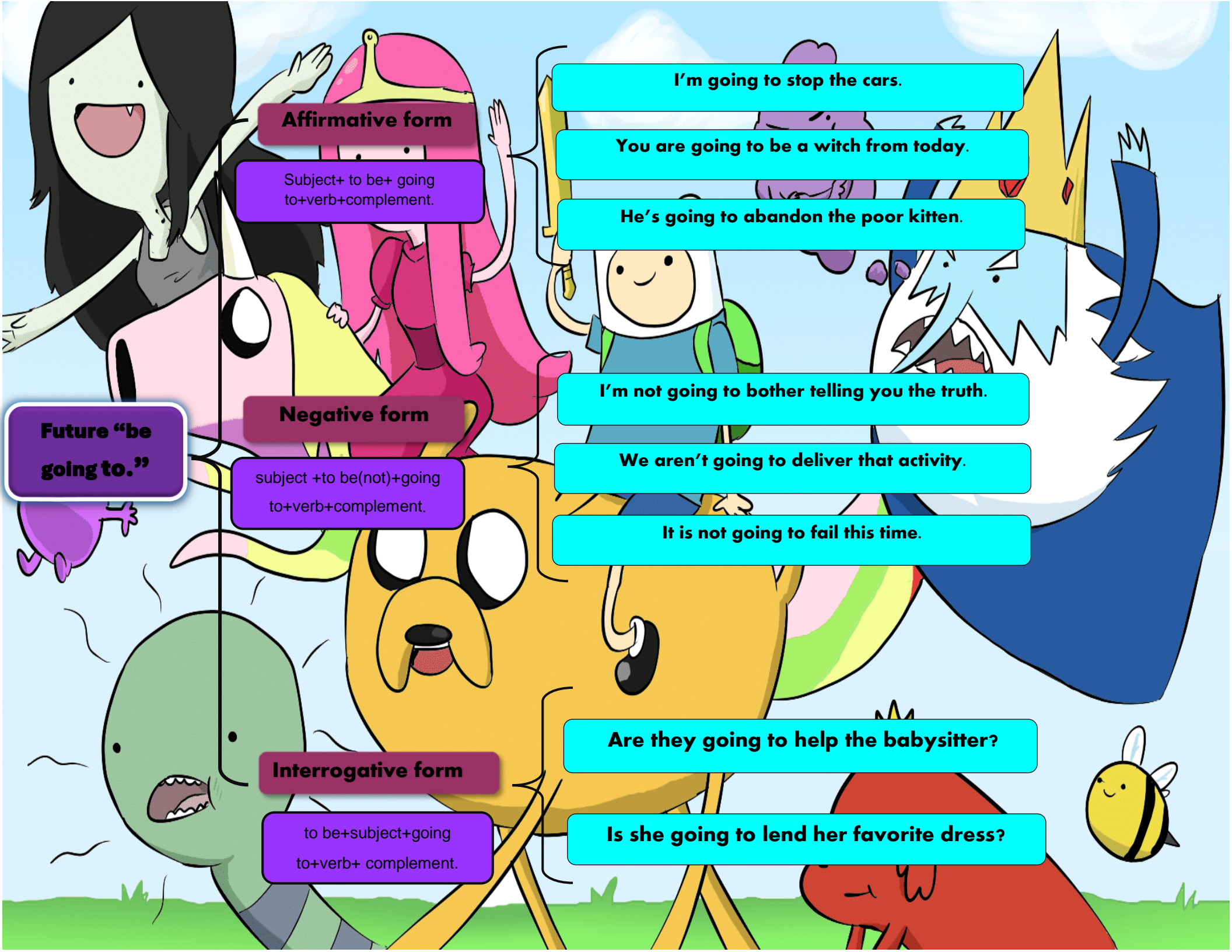

Affirmative form

Subject+ to be+ going
to+verb+complement.

I'm going to stop the cars.

You are going to be a witch from today.

He's going to abandon the poor kitten.

Negative form

subject +to be(not)+going
to+verb+complement.

I'm not going to bother telling you the truth.

We aren't going to deliver that activity.

It is not going to fail this time.

**Future "be
going to."**

Interrogative form

to be+subject+going
to+verb+ complement.

Are they going to help the babysitter?

Is she going to lend her favorite dress?
