+ verb + complemen.

## NEGATIVE FORM

Subject + to be (not) +  
going to + verb +  
complement.

I am not going to play friday .  
We are not going to study all night.  
It is not going to be a cood day.

## INTERROGATIVE FORM

To be + subject + going to  
+ verb + complement

Are they going to spend the day together?  
Is she going to talk to you?
