AFFIRMATIVE



subject + verb in past + complement

I, YOU, HE

- I PLAYED VIDEOGAMES LASTNIGHT
- YOU WENT TO THE CINEMA WITH HIM
- HE STUDIED ENGLISH FOR THE EXAM

NEGATIVE



subject + Negation + verb in present + complement

I, WE, IT

- I DIDN'T WATCH THE MOVIE YESTERDAY
- WE DIDN'T GO TO WORK THIS WEEKEND
- IT DIDN'T COST TOO MUCH

INTERROGATIVE



Question + subject + verb in present + complement

THEY, SHE

- DID SHE BUY THE PURSE FROM PRADA?
- DID THEY GO TO THE BEACH THIS SUMMER?
