- You played soccer with your friends.
- He ate dinner at a restaurant.

NEGATIVE FORM.
SUBJECT+NEGATION+
VERB IN
PRESENT+COMPLEMENT.

- I didn't go to the party on Saturday.
- We didn't watch the movie yesterday.
 - It didn't rain during our vacation.

INTERROGATIVE
FORM.
QUESTION+SUBJECT+
VERB IN
PRESENT+COMPLEMENT.

- Did they finish their homework on time?
- Did she buy a new dress for the party?
