# ORDERING SUPPLIES

<b>PILLOW</b>	What is it?	Resistant, soft, anatomical pillow, the foam's ability to return to its normal state after removing the applied weight.	What are they for?	Effectively prevent pressure ulcers, bed sores, relieve pain after surgery, and help the wound recover quickly.
<b>GAUZE</b>	What is it?	They are a type of mesh, with more or fewer threads, and the number of threads is what determines the quality of the gauze.	What are they for?	They can be used to clean, disinfect, protect or promote the healing process of any injury.
<b>CATHETER SET</b>	What is it?	Probe that is introduced through any canal in the body, natural or artificial, to explore or dilate it or to serve as a guide and vehicle for other instruments.	What are they for?	Intravenous catheters, that is, they enter through the intravenous route, these are used to transport nutrients and medications directly into the blood and thus towards the body. The catheters also work to connect to a machine known as dialysis that filters waste materials from the blood when the kidneys are not working properly.
<b>DISINFECTANT</b>	What is it?	Disinfectants are substances that are used to destroy microorganisms or inhibit their development, and that exert their action on an inert surface or inanimate object.	What are they for?	Disinfectants act by producing and killing bacteria by deactivating enzymes, hydrolysis and oxidation, working more selectively than antiseptics.
<b>SURGICAL TAPE</b>	What is it?	Hypoallergenic paper tape, latex-free, soft on the skin and minimal adhesive residue.	What are they for?	Used to heal wounds and secure medical tubes
<b>STERILE CUP</b>	What is it?	Sealed and sterilized to prevent any growth of bacteria or microorganisms inside the bottle before sample collection.	What are they for?	It serves to carry out the destruction of all bacteria, including their spores, without significantly altering the organoleptic and nutritional characteristics of the original product.

<b>SPECIMEN TUBE</b>	What is it?	It is a cylindrical glass container, closed at one end, used for small-scale experiments and analysis, especially in the laboratory.	What are they for?	It is used in laboratories to contain small liquid or solid samples, although they can have different phases, such as carrying out chemical reactions
<b>SCISSORS</b>	What is it?	Instrument made of very high quality stainless steel, used to make cuts in materials used in medical care	What are they for?	They are used to easily cut surgical sutures and fine surgical threads.
<b>HOSPITAL GOWN</b>	What is it?	Long, loose garment worn in a hospital by someone performing or undergoing an operation	What are they for?	It is intended to prevent contamination of the doctor's clothing with microorganisms, so as not to turn it into a fomite.
<b>IV BAG</b>	What is it?	A very thin, flexible catheter or tube that is inserted into a vein in the arm, hand, leg, or foot.	What are they for?	To administer medications or liquids
<b>BEDPAN</b>	What is it?	They help patients of both sexes who are bedridden and cannot go to the bathroom.	What are they for?	It allows you to comfortably meet all your physiological needs.
<b>SHEET</b>	What is it?	Unique set of information and personal data of a patient	What are they for?	Means for recording vital signs, thermal curve, fluid control, transfusions, invasive procedures, care plan, evaluation and finally a nursing diagnosis, obtaining the necessary information to provide comprehensive quality care.
