# HOSPITAL JOBS AND PERSONNEL.

**Charge Nurse:** Charge nurses oversee the operations of their specific nursing unit during a set period while working alongside the team. The primary role of a charge nurse is to ensure that all nursing functions within the department run smoothly and efficiently.



## THE CLEANER

Hospital cleaners provide cleaning services to hospitals and other healthcare settings, where they ensure a safe and hygienic environment for staff and patients. Through expert knowledge of cleaning products, procedures and equipment, they maintain the cleanliness of hospital floors, rooms, bathrooms and furniture.

## THE CONSULTANT



consultants help health care providers and institutions to grow and develop their services, while also considering the best outcomes for patients and taking account of regulations, health policies, and budgets.

## THE PARAMEDICS



Paramedics work in teams and will respond to any type of medical emergency and will work under the supervision of a doctor (even when the doctor is not on site).



## THE PORTER

Hospital porters are employed to move patients between wards and departments and to move goods and vital supplies including medical equipment, linen, blood, and samples.



## THE RECEPTIONIST

A hospital receptionist is the first point of contact between a hospital or medical facility and patients. These receptionists play an integral role in a medical facility because they perform customer service and administrative-related duties like scheduling appointments, answering patients' questions

## SURGEON.



A surgeon is a doctor who specializes in evaluating and treating conditions that may require surgery, or physically changing the human body. Surgeries can be done to diagnose or treat disease or injury.

## TRIAGE NURSE



Nurses who work in triage work in emergency rooms and other emergency clinical facilities to help establish what kind of care patients need, ensuring they get sent to the right locations as fast as possible.



## SCRUB NURSE

A Scrub Nurse is a nurse who assists surgeons during operations. They work exclusively in the OR, working alongside doctors to ensure a patient's procedure goes smoothly.
