CHARGE NURSE

They make sure everything runs smoothly and efficiently.



WHAT ARE YOU DOING?

- Supervise other nurses and unit staff
- Template creation
- Assignment of nurses to patients or tasks
- Supervise the transition from one shift to another

CLEANER

IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CARRYING OUT THE CLEANING, SANITIZATION AND DISINFECTION OF FLOORS, WALLS, CEILINGS AND FURNITURE ACCORDING TO THE ESTABLISHED CLEANING PROTOCOL



WHAT ARE YOU DOING?

Wash beds whenever a patient is discharged or dies. Carry out general and immediate cleaning when the doctor or nurse finishes their activities with patients

CONSULTANT

Advises on the contribution or solutions offered by ICT to improve the organization, management or provision of health services



WHAT ARE YOU DOING?

He is the ideal specialist to carry out medication reconciliation

PARAMEDIC

The paramedic is a professional who is responsible for attending to a medical emergency during the stage prior to the patient's admission to the hospital, clinic or sanatorium.



WHAT ARE YOU DOING?

They provide basic or advanced emergency medical care and evaluate injuries and illnesses.

PORTRESS

Employee who is in charge of guarding the door of a building or a company and who may also have other functions.



WHAT ARE YOU DOING?

They monitor staff and visitors, and may have responsibility for issuing or controlling entry passes.

RECEPCIONIST

A receptionist is a professional who serves clients or users of a building in a particular area known as the reception.



WHAT ARE YOU DOING?

Organize and manage telephone connections and communications between internal and external interlocutors of the company or entity.

SURGEON

Medical professional who removes or repairs parts of a patient's body through surgical operations.



WHAT ARE YOU DOING?

Operate on patients to correct deformities, repair injuries, prevent and treat disease, or improve or restore patient function

TRIAGE NURSE

The role of this nurse is to assess the patient in order to detect critical situations that endanger their life, and to be able to establish the priority of care among them, according to the clinical condition of each user.

INSTRUMENTALIST NURSE

They act as assistants to surgeons during surgical procedures.

Collect technical data on equipment, instruments and technologies to achieve the availability of information. Control the equipment, tools delivered and in common use calibration and measurement instruments to maintain their good condition, durability and calibration.
