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# \* PATIENT ADMISSIONS

### \*CHARGE NURSE

is the person responsible for the efficient management of a department in a clinic, hospital, or healthcare facility. Among other tasks, he is in charge of operational aspects, including admissions and discharge, as well as directing the activities of nurses and support staff in the department.

#### \* CLEANER

It is essential to ensure a safe and healthy environment for patients, medical staff and visitors. The work of these people is essential to maintain hygiene and disinfection in all areas of the hospital, from patient rooms to waiting rooms and common spaces.

## \*CONSULTANT

It is the time in which the patient is with the professional in a specific space (the office or home of the person suffering from the health problem), while the doctor provides his opinion and recommends the steps to follow.

#### \* PARAMEDIC

It is a health professional who is responsible for providing emergency medical care to patients who are in critical situations. These professionals have the ability to quickly assess the situation and make important decisions regarding patient care and transportation.

#### ★ PORTER

Hospital porter jobs include maintenance workers, cleaners, housekeepers, and patient assistants. Unlike most other medical center employees, people employed in hospital janitorial jobs do not attend medical training courses, and many janitorial jobs are entry-level positions that are filled by high school graduates.

# \* RECEPTIONIST

Order management, administration, customer service and many other activities are of course. The functions of a receptionist in hospitals are very important since without their management there would be no order and the place would not function properly.

#### \* SURGEON

It is any doctor who is capable of preventing, diagnosing and curing diseases by performing surgery. The title of general practitioner is awarded to professionals who have completed a medical degree in most Latin American countries. This degree allows them to practice medicine without specializing in any specific branch.

#### \* TRIAGE NURSE

Triage plays an important role in the primary care emergency service because, with its initial assessment, it classifies the degree of urgency, speeds up action in serious emergency situations, resolves part of the urgent visits and improves the health education of users. .

# \*SCRUB NURSE

They act as assistants to surgeons during surgical procedures. They provide practical assistance to surgeons during the operation and perform tasks such as passing medical equipment.

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
