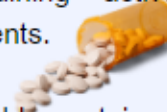
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Medication routes and forms

ENTERAL

ORAL:

- tablets: solid pharmaceutical form containing active ingredients with therapeutic activity and excipients.



- capsules: contain the medicine in a small soluble container, usually made of gelatin.



- syrup: is a medicine in the form of a thick liquid containing a sugar solution.



RECTAL

- suppository: a dosage form used to deliver medications by insertion into a body orifice rectal



PARENTERAL

intravenous:

- IVdrip: is a way of delivering high concentrations of vitamins and minerals directly into the bloodstream



- injection: the introduction of medication or biological products through pressure puncture into different body tissues



TOPICAL

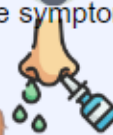
- ointment: drug with mixtures of water and fatty substances used on the skin to soothe or heal wounds



- drops: sterile aqueous or oily solutions or suspensions of one or more active ingredients, intended for instillation into the eye



- spray: nasal spray suspension is used to treat the symptoms of allergic rhinitis



INHALER: MEDICAL DEVICE USED TO DELIVER MEDICATION IN THE FORM OF DUST PARTICLES TO THE BODY THROUGH THE LUNGS.
