ROUTES AND FORMS OF MEDICATIONS

ORALLY

1

TABLETS: route of administration in which the medications are deposited in the oral cavity.



NASAL ROUTE

SPRAY: route of administration of a medication through the nostrils.

INTRAVENOUSLY

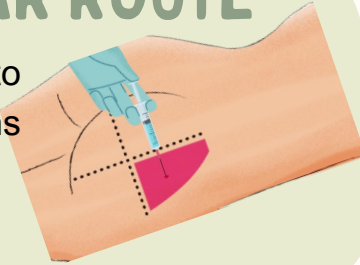
IV drip: Intravenous means "into a vein" and often refers to the administration of medications.

INTRAMUSCULAR ROUTE

Injection: Use of a syringe to introduce liquids or medications into the body.

ANAL

Suppository: Form of solid medication containing glycerin or similar material, which melts at body temperature

FORMS

Ointment: Substance used on the skin to soothe or heal wounds, burns, rashes.

FORMS

Drops: liquid medicine that is put into the eye in the form of drops in a dosed form



FORMS

syrup: aqueous preparation for oral use characterized by a sweet flavor and viscous consistency.

FORMS

Device: for delivering medications in the form of a sprayable liquid that is inhaled (breathed) through the nose or mouth



FORMS

Capsules: small containers or soluble containers generally made of gelatin, inside which is the dose of the drug
