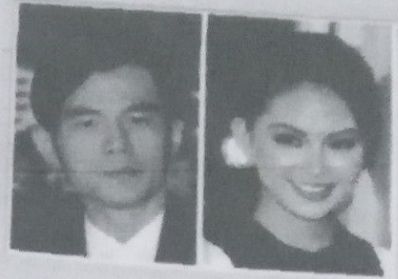
## Who Are They?

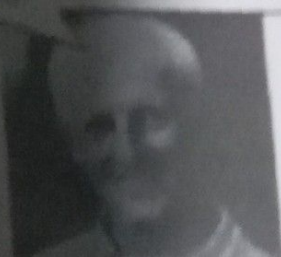
