<b>LEONBERGER</b>	Well proportioned in spite of its size.	Wary of strangers, cannot bear to be chained up	Fond of its owner, highly intelligent.
<b>ST. BERNARD</b>	Sturdy, strong and muscular	Sometimes irritable in hot climates.	Docile, faithful, courageous and generous.
<b>NEWFOUNDLAND AND LANDSEER</b>	Elegant in appearance, agile in movement.	NONE	Faithful and courageous
<b>PYRENEAN MOUNTAIN DOG</b>	Strong and muscular.	NONE	Gentle, calm, affectionate, courageous.
<b>BOXER</b>	Strong and hardy. Agile in movement, proud of bearing.	Wary of strangers.	Obedient and intelligent, easy to train.
<b>DOBERMANN (Dobermann Pinscher)</b>	Elegant and lithe in build, well muscled.	Reacts aggressively to provocation.	Intelligent, lively, courageous, faithful easy to train.
<b>SCHNAUZER</b>	Strong and hardy, compact in build.	Sometimes restless and dangerous with strangers.	Lively, faithful, easily trainable.
<b>GREAT DANE</b>	Strong and elegant, proud of bearing.	Suspicious of strangers.	Obedient and faithful to its owner, docile and even-tempered.
<b>HOVAWART</b>	Strong and hardy.	Retains its happy-go-lucky puppy temperament too long.	Intelligent and obedient.
<b>ROTTWEILLER</b>	Strong but of rather heavy build.	Aggressive and dangerous with strangers.	Intelligent; faithful to its owner.
