	QUALITIES	MAIN PHYSICAL DEFECTS	DEFECTS
BREED BREVEDAD LEONBERGER	Fond of its owner highly intelligent.	Head resembling a st. Bernard, tail curled over the back, white markings on the coat.	Wary of strangers, cannot bear to be chained up.
BREED ST. BERNARD	Docile, faithful, courageous and generous.	Swayback, tail curled over the back, curly or excessively long coats, self-coloured coat or lack of white.	Sometimes irritable in hot climates.
BREED NEWFOUNDLAND LANDSEER	Faithful and courageous.	Sway back, weak loinst, tail curved over the back in action, cow hocks, presence of dew claws, feet turning outwards.	None.
BREED PYRENEAN MOUNTAIN DOG	Gentle, calm, affectionate, courageous.	Excessively heavy head, pronounced stop, round, prominent eyes, undershot jaw, cow hocks, absence of two sets of dew claws at the back.	None.
BREED BOXER	Obedient and intelligent, easy to train.	Heavy appearance, light nose, light eyes, jaw showing, tongue and teeth visible when the mouth is shut, missing teeth, tail set low, white marking on the coat, covering more than one third of the total surface area.	Wary of strangers.
BREED DOBERMANN	Intelligent, lively, courageous, faithful easy to train.	Heavy appearance, excessively large head, pronounced stop, light eyes, overshot or undershot jaw, presence of dewlap, incorrect stance, straw-colored coat, white markings on the chest, tan markings not clearly defined.	Reacts aggressively to provocation.
BREED SCHNAUZER	Lively, faithful, easily trainable.	Wrinkles on the forehead, light eyes, undershot jaw, presence of dewlap, cow hocks, wavy coat, atypical colouring.	Sometimes responds and dangerous with strangers.
BREED GREAT DANE	Obedient and faithful to its owner, docile and even-tempered.	Snipy muzzle, missing teeth, overshot or undershot jaw, even bite, short neck, presence of dewlap, sway back, incorrect stance; curled tail, colour not conforming to the standard.	Suspicious of strangers.
BREED HOVAVART	Intelligent and obedient.	Undershot or overshot jaw, ears wide apart, swayback, hind legs not well angled, tail curled over the back, curly coat.	Retains its happy-go-lucky puppy temperament too long.
BREED ROTTWEILER	Long muzzle with excessively drooping lips, narrow skull, light eyes, light build, thin tail.	Long muzzle with excessively drooping lips, narrow skull, light eyes, light build, thin tail.	Aggressive and dangerous with strangers.
