# CANCER IN PET ANIMALS

## NEOPLASIA

neoplasia is the uncontrolled, abnormal growth of cells or tissues in the body

Neoplasia is often suspected on the basis of the pet's medical history and physical exam. Additional tests, such as radiographs (x-rays), blood tests, and ultrasound exams, may be necessary to confirm neoplasia

## TUMORS

it can be benign or malignant. Benign neoplasms do not grow aggressively.

The word "tumor" or "mass" is often used to describe the actual swelling or other physical appearance of a neoplasm.

## CANCER

is often confused with neoplasia, but only malignant neoplasms are truly cancers.

The word "cancer" is often confused with neoplasia, but only malignant neoplasms are truly cancers
