Affirmative Form Grammatical structure:

SUBJECT + **TO BE** + **VERB+ING**
+ **COMPLEMENT.**

- I am studying for my exams.
- You are cooking dinner tonight.
- He is watching a movie with friends.

Negative Form Grammatical structure:

SUBJECT + **TO BE** + **NOT** +
VERB+ING + **COMPLEMENT.**

- I am not working today.
- We are not preparing dinner together.
- She is not reading a book right now.

Interrogative Form Grammatical structure:

TO BE + **SUBJECT** + **VERB+ING** +
COMPLEMENT?

- Are they coming to the meeting?
- Is it making a loud noise?
