Affirmative Form Grammatical structure:

SUBJECT + **VERB** +
COMPLEMENT.

- I play soccer every day.
- You work very hard.
- We enjoy reading books.
- They live in New York.
- He studies English in the morning.
- She cooks delicious meals.
- It looks beautiful at night.

Negative Form Grammatical structure:

SUBJECT + **DON'T - DOESN'T** +
VERB + **COMPLEMENT.**

- You don't watch TV often.
- She doesn't wake up early on weekends.

Interrogative Form Grammatical structure:

DO - DOES + **SUBJECT** + **VERB** +
COMPLEMENT?

- Do you like pizza?
- Does it make a loud noise?
