1: I am Katia.

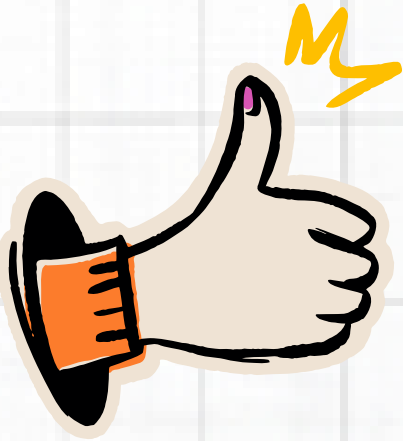
Negative form:
Subject + Verb + Not + Complement
1: I am not Katia.

Interrogative form:
Verb + Subject + Complement + ?
1: Am I Katia?

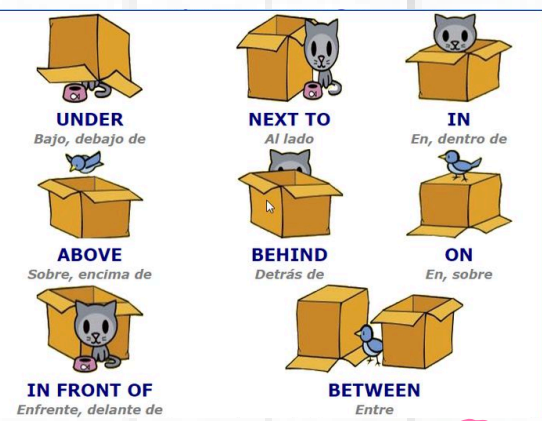
