Affirmative form
Subject+ Verb+ Complement

- *I'm Mary.*
- *You're my teacher.*
- *He's at school.*
- *She's a babysitter.*
- *It's a car.*
- *We are the bosses.*
- *They're my brother.*

Negative form
Subject+ Verb+ Complement

- *I'm not dancer.*
- *He isn't studying.*
- *She isn't absent form class today.*
- *It isn't a meeting.*
- *We are not athletes.*
- *You're not ready togo.*
- *They are not playing.*

Interrogative form
Verb+ Subject+ Complement?

- *Am I wrong?*
- *Are you the best you classroom?*
- *Is he a good friend?*
- *Is she sick today?*
- *Is it a sunny day?*
- *Are we last?*
- *Are they brothers?*
