English prepositions of place are words that indicate the location, position or direction of an object or person in relation to others in a sentence. They also serve as connectors within the sentence, indicating the place where the action takes place or the situation occurs.



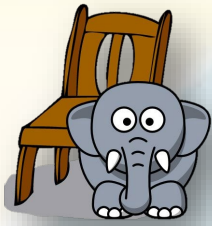
Examples.



- The fox is **in** the bush.



- The cat is **in** the box.



- The elephant is **in front of** the chair.

In front of.



- The rabbit is **in front of** the bursh.



- The girl is **behind** the box.

Behind.



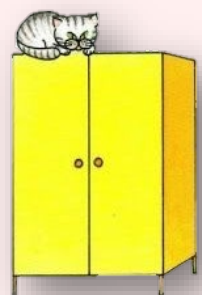
- The sun is **behind** the cloud.



- The dog is **on** the armchairs.

On.

Note: The surfaces do touch each other.



- The cat is **on** the closet.



Next to.

- The ice cream is **next to** the coffee cup.



- The pants are **next to** the blouse.



Under.

- The dog is **under** the table.



- The frog is **under** the mushroom.



Above.

Note: Surfaces do not touch each other.



- The clock is **above** the chimney.

- The pictures are **above** the lovesofa.



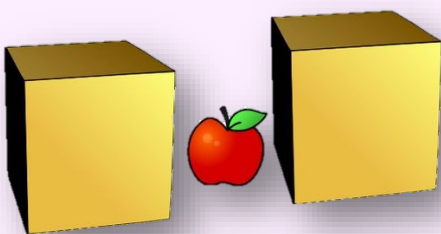
At.

Between.

- The apple is **between** the boxes.



- The table is **between** the chairs.
